Please note: below is a general summary of what is offered for Museum field trips; field trips will be adjusted to fit your group's age and needs.

History of Firefighting: Ever wondered how firefighters went from fighting fires with buckets of water to operating the humongous fire trucks of today? Bring your group and learn all about the history of firefighting through an interactive tour. After the tour, see if your group can beat the clock at the popular bucket brigade interactive. This part of the tour meets NYS Social Studies Learning Standards for grades Pre-K-2.





Dare to be Prepared: Come and learn about fire safety and prevention, as we take your class through a hazard house, teach them about when to dial 9-1-1, when to stop, drop and roll, tools and toys and other fire safety and prevention concepts. Students then will have the opportunity to enjoy the Museum's interactive discovery trucks. This part of the tour meets NYS Learning Standards for grades Pre-K-2.
